The JLLC's Branch Out and Grow Grant is again available to educators in the five-parish area (Calcasieu, Cameron, Jefferson Davis, Beauregard, and Allen.) For several years, this program has supported the enhancement of student experiences by awarding monetary grants ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 and by contributing the time of League members with volunteer hours as requested by applicants. ## Taking Education and Children Higher

The Junior League of Lake Charles, Inc.'s (JLLC) TEACH Grant celebrates our 90-year history of forging positive partnerships with the community of Southwest Louisiana by inviting the community to participate in the selection of one (1) applicant to receive a \$5,000 grant award.

The JLLC will select finalists from the pool of applicants. Those selected will prepare tabletop presentations to be displayed at the 2023 Mistletoe and Moss holiday market, which runs from Friday, November 17, 2023, through Sunday, November 19, 2023. Mistletoe and Moss attendees will be able to cast one ballot per admission ticket for their favorite presentation. The applicant whose presentation receives the most votes will be awarded the TEACH Grant.

Teachers wishing to be considered for the \$5,000 TEACH Grant must submit the full application, along with signatures, no later than Friday, October 20, 2023, to be considered for the \$5000 TEACH Grant.

Although there are separate applications for the TEACH and Branch Out and Grow grants, applicants may choose to submit the same proposal for both programs or may tailor their applications for each. Applicants may also submit separate proposals for each grant given the different opportunities each grant may provide.

Applicants are not required to submit proposals to both grant applications in order to be considered or awarded for either grant.

All applicants for the TEACH Grant will be notified November 6th& 7th in order to provide sufficient time to prepare Mistletoe and Moss presentations.

- 1. If I am selected as a finalist, I will create a visual presentation communicating the objectives and benefits of my grant proposal to be displayed at the 2023 Mistletoe and Moss holiday market. The presentation will consist of, at minimum, one (1) 48" x 36" tri-fold display board. I will adhere to any additional restrictions or requirements placed on the presentation display by the Junior League of Lake Charles, Inc.
- 2. I will be available to set up my presentation during the week of November 17, 2023, at the Lake Charles Civic Center **prior** to the opening of the market.
- 3. I will be available to remove my presentation from the Lake Charles Civic Center on Sunday, November 19, 2023.
